EXCLUSIVE FOR PEOPLE WITH DOMICILE IN THE METROPOLITAN REGION

**TEMPORARY VISA:** Is the Residence Permit that allows its main holder to reside in the country and to perform any licit activities, without especial limitations.

### A. GENERAL DOCUMENTS TO APPLY FOR A VISA FOR THE FIRS TIME (It must be sent for the main holder and dependents

- ❖ **2 photocopy of the valid passport (identification pages, number as well as expiration and granting dates of the bear holder, page with the entry stamp).Do not forget to show the original passport**
- ❖ **1 photocopy of the Valid Tourism Card. Do not forget that you must present the original 2 recent color photographs, id size (3x2 cm.), with full name and passport number.**

### B. SPECIFIC DOCUMENTS FOR THE MAIN HOLDER

#### 1. TEMPORARY VISA FOR PENSIONER

- ❖ 2 photocopies of the last 3 monthly pension payment slip, legalized in front or notary or,
- ❖ 2 photocopies of the Consul Certificate of the country of origin in which the income is certified due to a pension of the applicant, in local currency or its equivalent in dollars, legalized by a notary.
- ❖ Any document issued abroad, must be legalized by the Chilean Consulate in the country of origin and translated and legalized by the Chilean Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

#### 2. TEMPORARY VISA FOR FINANCIERS

To certify the financier condition, by the submitting of certificates of ownership or leasing contracts that are in Chile or abroad, or any other similar document that indicate the periodically obtains economic resources. Which ever the document may be, it must be a photocopy legalized in front of a notary. And a simple photocopy..

Any document that is issued abroad, must be legalized in the Chilean Consulate of the country of origin and it must be translated and legalized by the Chilean Ministry of Foreign Affairs

### C.- SPECIFIC DOCUMENTATION FOR DEPENDENTS. (these people are not allowed to work).

- ❖ **SPOUSE:** Original marriage certificate or a copy that has been authorized by a notary
- ❖ **CHILDREN:** Original birth certificate, in which the names of the parents is indicates or a copy that has been authorized by a notary and a simple photocopy..
- ❖ **PARENTS OF THE MAIN HOLDER:** Original birth certificate of the main holder, in which the name of the parents are indicated, or a copy that has been authorized by a notary.
- ❖ Sworn declaration of expenses, in which the main holder of the visa assumes the cost of the maintenance of his/hers dependents in the country, signed in front of a notary (original and copy)..  
**Prove source of income of your supported in Chile.** For more information see form Te-10.

### IMPORTANT

- ❖ Everyone that is applying to a visa Subject to a Contract as a main holder can request a working permit with visa in process. The cost of this permit is equivalent to 50% of the amount of a visa subject to a contract and is valid from the day it is requested, until the visa is stamped in the passport of the applicant.
- ❖ The document to prove the relationship between a **main holder and the dependents**, must be legalized by the Chilean Consulate in the country of origin and by the Chilean Foreign Relations Ministry.. In the case that the information that is being submitted is in any language other that Spanish, it must be legalized in the Chilean Consulate of the country of origin and translated and legalized by the Chilean Foreign Relations Ministry. If the document is written in English, French, Italian or Portuguese, no translation is needed.
